

Unsupervised Time Policy – Under 18s

The British Council considers any student under the age of 18 years as a 'junior'. This means that we are to take particular steps to ensure the happiness and safety of any students aged 16 or 17 years.

It also means that your parents have completed a Parental Consent Form that gives permission for your host to monitor your free time. This is purely for your safety. They have your mobile phone number.

There are four important rules to remember:

- . You must let your host know where you will be any time that you are not in their home, in class or taking part in a Celc activity or excursion
- . You must not purchase and consume alcohol or illegal drugs
- . You must be home in the evening by 23:00hrs
- . You are strongly encouraged to participate in Celc activities, excursions and the Social Club programme. As an U18, the cost of some or all of these activities and excursions is included in the fees you have paid.

Note: U16s will always be part of a closed group. Unsupervised time is monitored by the Group Leader. The group leader will also set an appropriate time for the student to be home in the evening and this might be earlier than 23:00hrs. Hosts will be notified of the time.
